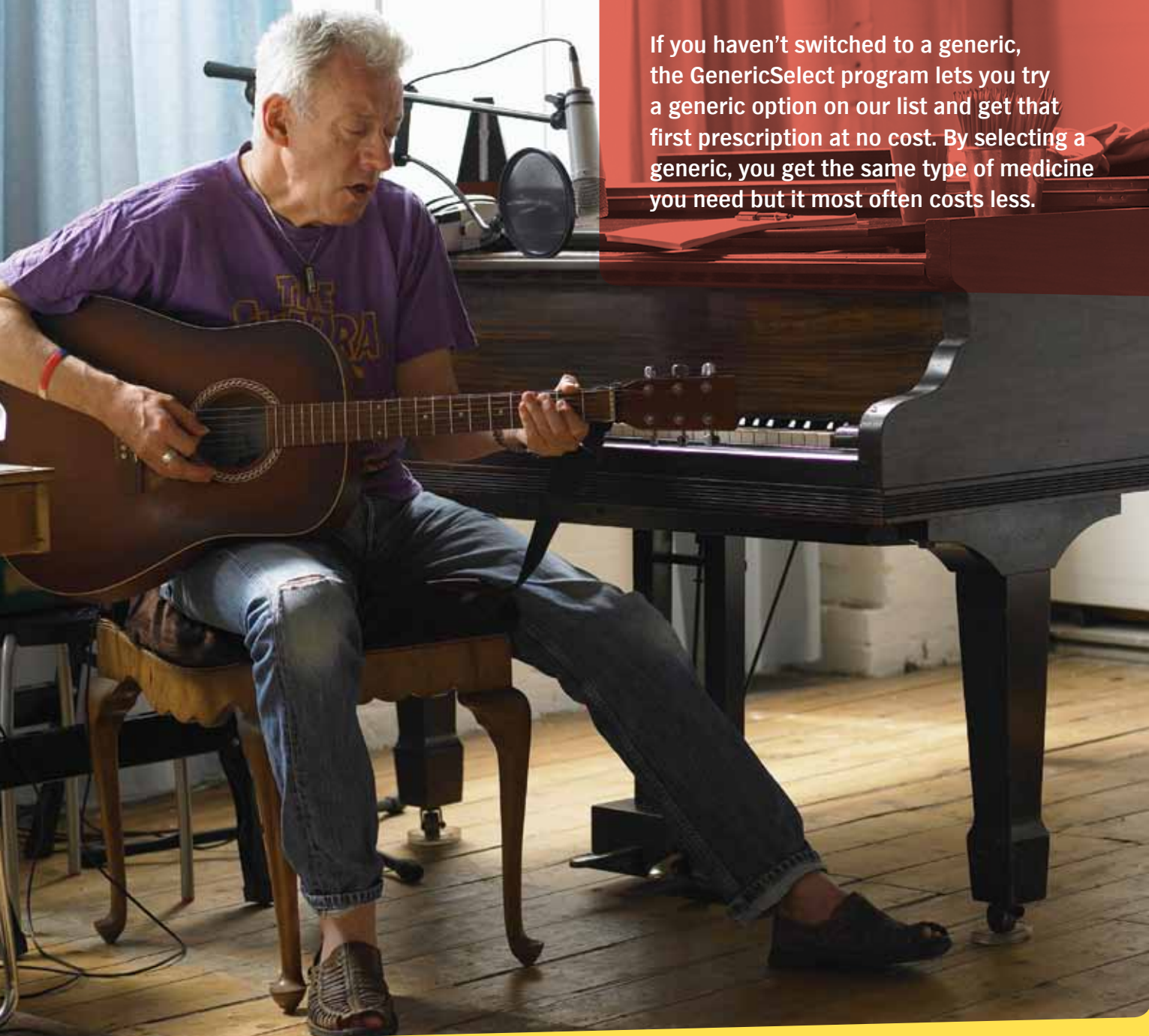


GenericSelect™

If you haven't switched to a generic, the GenericSelect program lets you try a generic option on our list and get that first prescription at no cost. By selecting a generic, you get the same type of medicine you need but it most often costs less.



What is GenericSelect?

It's a program that lets you try a generic option on our list at no cost the first time you fill a new prescription. And, since generics cost less than brand-name drugs, you save money every time you refill the prescription for the generic after your first fill.

How to Get Started with GenericSelect.

First speak to your doctor to see if one of the GenericSelect generic drugs is right for you. If it is, your doctor should give you a new prescription for that drug.

Try a generic, on us.

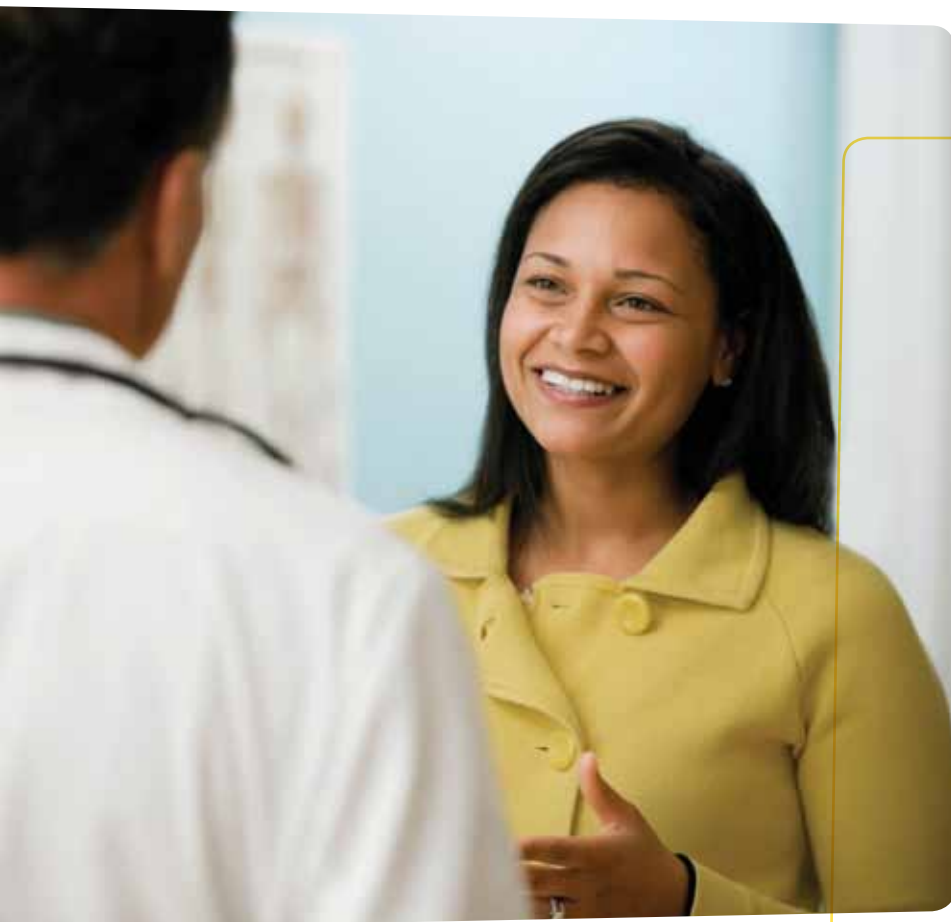
· If you're now taking a brand-name drug that is on our list, you can switch to a GenericSelect drug and get your first generic prescription at no cost to you. There's no copayment. And, you'll only pay your usual generic copays for all future refills.

· Or, if you fill a prescription using a generic on the list without ever having used the brand-name drug before, you can get your first prescription at no cost to you.

Two great ways to save – retail or home delivery.

1. You can take your new prescription to a retail pharmacy and get a 30-day supply at no cost to you. (If the prescription is for alendronate, you'll get a 28-day supply at no cost).
2. Or you can send your new prescription to our preferred Home Delivery Pharmacy and get up to a 90-day supply at no cost to you. You'll refill your prescriptions fewer times, and that means fewer copays. Saving you even more money. And, your prescriptions will be sent to your home.

Either way, you'll only have to pay your usual generic copays for all future refills. That way, you will keep saving as long as you use the GenericSelect drug.



Is a generic right for me?

Ask your doctor if a GenericSelect drug might be right for you instead of the brand-name drugs on our list. And never switch any medicine until you talk to your doctor. The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) states that generics must have the same high standards for purity, quality, safety and strength as brand-name drugs. Generics and brand-name drugs have the same active ingredient, strength and dose. Because generics must meet the same standards as brand-name drugs, you can be sure the generic is just as safe and works just as well.

*Preferred brand – If your doctor feels you can switch from a preferred brand drug to a GenericSelect option, you'll have the lowest copay.

**Non-preferred brand – When you take a non-preferred brand drug, you pay the highest copay or you may even pay the total cost of the non-preferred brand drug. Ask your doctor if switching to a GenericSelect option is right for you and save on your prescription drug costs.



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
