The following information is representative of typical on-site clinic services available to eligible employees & family members. Services provided via the clinic are **FREE** of charge, including prescription drugs dispensed through the clinic. Days & hours of operation to be determined jointly by the client and the clinic manager selected as a result of the RFP process:

DIAGNOSIS & TREATMENT

- Minor arthritis
- Diabetes
- Headaches, including migraine
- High Cholesterol & Hypertension
- Hypothyroidism
- Minor lacerations, including suturing
- Osteoporosis
- Rashes, bites, stings & acne
- Mental health (depression, anxiety, insomnia, etc.)*
- Respiratory Issues: colds, sore throat, ear aches, sinusitis, allergy, asthma & bronchitis
- Routine/Non-specific: chest, abdominal, back, Musculoskeletal pain
- Strains & sprains
- Urinary complaints

SCREENING, TREATMENT & PREVENTION

- Allergy injections**
- Annual physical exams/gynecologic care
- Pediatric services for children over 1 year
- Depo-Provera injections
- Hepatitis B, Tetanus vaccination as needed

TESTING

- Blood draws for lab services
- Fecal occult blood
- Fingerstick glucose
- Hearing acuity
- Office-based spirometry (lung function)**
- Oximetry (monitors oxygen level in blood)
- Strep throat screening
- Urinalysis
- Urine drug screening
- Urine pregnancy testing
- Vaginal wet prep
- Visual acuity (screening only)

PHARMACY

Many commonly prescribed generic medications – List of drugs to be dispensed is determined prior to clinic opening

GENERAL CLINIC SERVICE EXCLUSIONS

- Dispensing of controlled substances of any kind (can offer follow-up care)
- Service for drug or alcohol addiction (can offer follow-up care)
- Fracture management (can provide follow-up care)
- Obstetrical care (can provide follow-up care)
- Radiological services (x-ray, CT, etc)
- Routine 'well child" immunizations
- Any services that would be better treated by a medical specialist
- Injuries and conditions that may be reasonably viewed as eligible for Workers Compensation claim
