[x]	<u>Curriculum and Resources</u>
	The Principal is tasked with the responsibility to evaluate the Corporation's efforts to discourage the use of tobacco by students and staff and formulate recommendations annually to the Superintendent regarding improvements to the in-school and after-school programs.
	The Principal shall be responsible for the annual evaluation of resources available to support the Corporation's curricula whereby students are educated about the health hazards inherent in the use of tobacco and tobacco products. Resources selected for this purpose shall be evidence-based and, as such, shall be endorsed by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, the United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the National Institute of Health, the National Cancer Institute, the American Cancer Society, or similar organizations.

Communications Plan

Each principal or site administrator shall include a link to the Board's policies that prohibit smoking by students, staff, and visitors on the home page of the website for their school or ancillary facility, and shall include either a link to the policies or the policies verbatim in handbooks that are published for students, parents, and staff. Copies of the policies shall be provided by staff in the office of that facility upon request of visitors, vendors, or parents.
