

**Resolution 2020-11
Ratification of Superintendent's
Emergency Actions**


On March 6, 2020, Indiana Governor Eric Holcomb issued Executive Order 20-02, a **Declaration of Public Health Emergency for Coronavirus Disease 2019 Outbreak**. In response to this declared emergency, the Culver Community Schools Corporation Superintendent and the Superintendent's designees have taken certain actions to protect the safety of students, employees and the community. The Superintendent now notifies the Board of School Trustees of those actions for the purpose of ratification.

| <u>Date</u> | <u>Emergency Action Taken</u> |

| May 5 | Approved students to enter the building to complete testing or other continuous learning activities if students have communicated with a teacher for permission and social distancing requirements are met. |
| May 5 | Approved the use of the HS auditorium on May 16 th by the Culver Police Department because testing of candidates for the police department is an essential function and social distancing requirements will be met. |
| May 5 | Students will keep iPADS over the summer accept Seniors and those students not returning in the Fall 2020. |
| May 7 | Submitted Graduation Plan to Health Department because graduation is an essential function and the social distancing, health and safety guidelines, and gathering limitations set out in Executive Order 20-08 are met. <u>Plan</u> |

- May 11 Approved changing grading scale changes for final grade calculations: 75% 3rd 9 weeks, 25% 4th 9 weeks.
- May 12 Changed Retirement Breakfast to Celebration
- May 13 Approved use of Administration Building for Voting on May 30th and June 2nd because voting is an essential function.
- May 13 Approved students to enter building during scheduled times to return items and clean out lockers at MSHS or pick up locker items at CES.
- May 13 Teachers to return to building to work the week of May 26-May 29th unless age 65 or older or medically fragile. The social distancing, health and safety guidelines, and gathering limitations set out in Executive Order 20-08 are met for Stage 3.

This Resolution is approved and the actions of the Superintendent and the Superintendent's designees are ratified by the Culver Community Schools Corporation Board of School Trustees on May 18, 2020.
