

Meal Service Guidelines:

Culver Community High School/Middle School participates in the National School Breakfast/Lunch Program and makes them available to students for a fee. Ala Carte items are available to purchase as well. Students may also bring their own lunch to be eaten in the school cafeteria. No outside vendors can deliver meals to students. No students shall be allowed to leave school premise during the lunch period without specific written permission granted by the principal.

If Middle/School Students have over a \$5.00 negative balance, they are notified by the ECA Treasurer. They are offered the PB & J Lunch with all the requirements needed. If a student has a negative balance, no meal charging is allowed and students are not allowed to buy any extra/ala carte items.

Elementary students are notified at least three times a week by e-mail and if they don't have e-mails a note is sent to them if they have a negative balance. Students are offered the normal lunch and they do not have any ala carte items available.

Applications for the school's free and reduced priced meal program can be found online through Harmony or a student may pick up an application from the school's ECA Treasurer.
